

FINAL INSTRUCTIONS TO COMPETITORS WESTONZOYLAND

We need to make a number of changes to our procedures to enable us to run an event. Please take note of extra signage and comply with their instructions.

- 1 Each competitor may only be accompanied by one person.
- 2 No spectators will be admitted.
- 3 No day entries will be accepted on the day of the meeting.
- 4 Social distancing measures must be adhered to when parking.
- 5 It is recommended that gloves and face masks are worn when appropriate.
- 6 Bring your own pen to signing on.
- 7 There will be an area designated to machine examining. Leave your machine and clothing for technical verification and later collection. Wipe your helmet before and after examination. Don't forget a stand.
- 8 There will be no catering.
- 9 Timing tickets will not be issued but rider's times will be listed and displayed periodically inside the timing van window.
- 10 Hand sanitisers will be at various locations, please use them whenever it is appropriate.
- 11 Complete the enclosed signing on form and bring it with your payment to signing on. Show them to the official for checking and then put them in a box where they will remain for 84 hrs before processing. Follow sanitising protocol instructions if you need a day licence. Each competitor will need to show their ACU competition licence. Competitors should hold the licence and other forms sufficiently for the Race Office staff to be able to view the photograph and signatures and turn the licence on the flip side so the Race Office staff can view the reverse of the licence at a distance of two metres.
- 12 If a competitor falls / loses contact with his machine during the course of practice / racing, if able to do so, he is to give the Marshals 'the thumbs up' to indicate he is unhurt. If, however, the competitor is unable to do this, the Marshals will react in the normal manner and tend to the competitor wearing appropriate PPE (face masks / gloves). Medical support will be deployed as per the request of Marshals to Race Control. Competitors and Officials should bear in mind that due to Covid-19 restrictions, this may cause additional delays which may cause a delay to the race programme.
